- Currently has funding for 14 homes from American Red Cross for \$15,000 per home.
 - 1 – Closed
 - 1 – Completed (Soon to be 2)
 - 4 – In Progress (Quotes approved & project started)
 - 5 – Pending (Waiting on Quotes)
- Still looking for additional referrals. APDR should be able to do more than 14 homes because projects have not used the \$15,000 max. (Scope is small or use of volunteers, etc. keeps projects well under the max)
- Partnered with Mosaic in Action & AmeriCorp NCCC members to do mold remediation in Liverpool.
- Looking for volunteers to do projects such as painting, moving 300 tires from a resident's home, and other home repair projects.
- Seeking a source for dumpsters.
